

CATHEDRAL WINDOW SUPPLY LIST

This is a hand piecing technique class. The Cathedral Window is a patchwork project sometimes called a "Beggars Quilt" because no two window patches should be the same fabric. You can choose to make a pincushion, small runner, or pillow top. However, the project you choose can "Grow" as large as you choose to make it. It is a quilt as you go project, so it is done when you decide it is done.

Required Materials:

Quality Muslin for block base - cut at least (16) 7" squares or more.

*Preparation prior to class - fold squares in half and machine stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam along both short edges of the formed rectangle.

(24 or more) 2" square scraps of a variety of prints (a charm pack would be great for this). If you so choose - all scraps can be the same color.

Needle, thread to match muslin, pins, thimble, scissors, rotary cutter, ruler and mat. Recommended tool - "That Purple Thang". No machine required.
