

Vest Material list and Information

Vest pattern - Keep it simple. Not too detailed. I have several I will bring to share if you would rather not purchase one. If you purchase one, follow the guide on the pattern for purchase of fabric amounts.

If you would like to use one of my patterns, 1 3/4 yards for the vest and 1 3/4 yards for the lining is a good choice. (Don't want to be short.)

Batiks work well for this, but so do other fabrics. Large, calm prints are good choices. Pre wash or not, it doesn't matter. If you don't want any shrinkage of your vest, pre wash.

I have visited with Faye at Faye's Henhouse and she will have the Texture Magic at her booth. She will also have some embellishments, buttons to cover, crystals, we will see what else we can come up with!

There are several choices for batting. Traditional batting, no batting, or flannel. Flannel is nice, it gives some structure but not as much bulk. The yardage for this depends on the width.

Sewing Machine

Pins

Scissors

Thread

Steam iron (I will have a super one to use, so don't worry about this too much) But you will need one for pressing seams and such.
