

## **Dresden Dining Supply List**

Approximate size: 17 ½" x 52"

**Fabrics:** Background – ¾ yd.

Sashing – ½ yd.

Assorted fabrics for the Dresden Plates (3 blocks) – 2 ½" x 4 ¼" rectangles of 16 fabrics for each block for a total of 48 rectangles.

Featherweight nonwoven interfacing (not fusible web) – 1 square 8" x 8"

Besides BSK, monofilament thread for appliqué, freezer paper or template plastic for making templates, paper scissors, marking pencil, masking tape, and a small quilting ruler such as 1" x 6".

Sewing machine must have a zigzag or a blind hem stitch.

Because there will be bias edges, you may want to use spray starch or sizing on the assorted Dresden Plate fabrics, before cutting, to help keep them from stretching.

**Cutting Directions:** Do before class. Bring extra fabric to class.

Background – Cut 1 strip 11" wide. Subcut into 3 squares 11" x 11" and 4 squares 3 ¼" x 3 ¼".

-- Cut 6 strips 1 ¼" wide.

Sashing -- Cut 9 strips 1 ¼" wide.

Assorted fabrics for the blocks – 2 ½" x 4 ¼" rectangles of 16 fabrics for each block for a total of 48 rectangles.
