## Mexican Star Dance


"Mexican Star Dance" is the much anticipated expansion of the popular "Mexican Stars" pattern. Due to many requests for a bigger, bedsized version of Mexican Stars this new variation is now available. It uses the same easy strip-piecing technique and dimensional curves and is enlarged to make the pattern suitable for a bed size quilt or throw. The various blocks are expanded in both size and number to make the two new versions included in this pattern. To further enlarge the quilts just add another border.

Version I - Square Diamond Setting: 80" x 80". Version II - Rectangular Side by Side Setting: 65" x 80".

- \*\* The word "folded" as part of the cutting instructions identifies pieces to be folded in step 2 below.
- 2. Folding and Preparation: Fold the following fabrics as indicated, then press with a warm iron to hold the folded shape of the fabric pieces.



To make folded triangles, fold the following squares in half diagonally, wrong sides together.

Version I -Diamond

152 - 41/4" light squares
8 - 31/2" dark squares
8 - 3" accent squares
8 - 21/2" bright squares
4 - 21/2" bright squares
