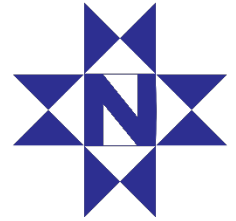


North Star Quilters Guild October 2019 Outreach Workshop



Join fellow quilters in sewing for outreach following our October guild meeting. The Outreach committee promises it will be easy mindless sewing so that you can enjoy comradery with guild members and get better acquainted in a relaxed atmosphere.

Outreach has planned two different projects for outreach. You can choose the one you want or try both!

Option 1: Fabric and pattern will be provided to make the great drawstring totes that Jeanette R. has been donating to outreach. We will be donating these totes to CVIC for Christmas. We have so many Christmas panels and Christmas fabrics. CVIC makes up baskets for families in crisis during the holidays and hopefully they will be able to use these totes to package up items for those families. Kind of like a large Christmas stocking.

Option 2: Using 5-inch squares or charm packs. If you have a charm pack or two you are willing to donate that would be awesome! We will provide fabric that day but we may need to do some cutting.

For both options:

- Bring your machine, basic sewing supplies: mat, rotary cutter, ruler, neutral thread, and any other notions you might require to sew blocks.
- We also need people to cut, press and sort fabrics for blocks. These will be very scrappy blocks and we will try to keep them in bright colorways. But we won't turn away other charm pack colors!

If you can't make it but are willing to sew a few blocks for the cause here is a block diagram.

Thanks!

- (4) 5" squares in a variety of colors
- Leave one whole for center,
- Cut (3) into 2½" x 5" pieces
- Assemble as shown.
- Trim to 8½" square.

Blocks will rotate so there won't be seams to match!
